- It contains a predicate and a subject. The predicate, or verb, tells what the subject, or noun is doing.
 - * NO A great story about a boy.
 - * YES Charlie reads a great story about a

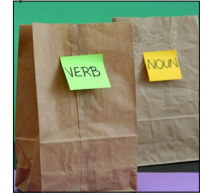

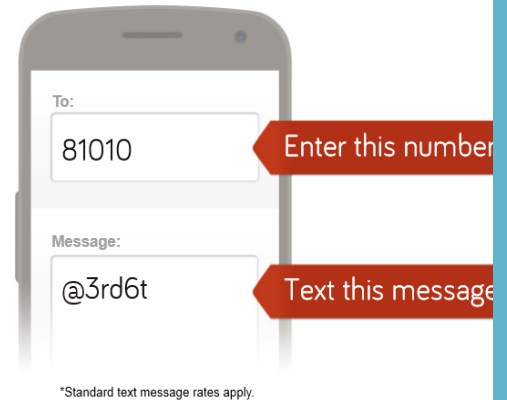

1. YOUR / YOU'RE

Your

"Your" is a possessive pronoun, as in "your car" or "your blog."




You're

"You're" is a contraction of "you are," as in: "You're screwing up your writing by using 'your' when you mean 'you are.'"

2. IT'S / ITS

It's

"It's" is a contraction of "it is" or "it has."



It's an apple!

Its

"Its" is a possessive pronoun, as in: "This infographic has got its groove on." Say your sentence out loud using "it is" instead. If that sounds goofy, "its" is likely correct.

3. THERE / THEIR / THEY'RE

There / Their

Always do the "That's ours!" test: Are you talking about more than one person and something they possess? If so, "their" will get you there.

That's ours!

They're

"They're" is a contraction of "they are," so talk it out to be sure.

Choosing a Cell Phone Plan—Verizon

Investigating Linear Equations



“When am I ever going to use this?”
Using the concepts in this worksheet, you will be able to determine which cell phone plan is the best value.

In 2008, Verizon offered the following cell phone plans to consumers. (Source: www.verizon.com)

Verizon: Nationwide Basic		
Monthly Anytime Minutes	Monthly Fee	Charge for Extra Minutes
450 minutes	\$39.99	\$0.45 per minute
900 minutes	\$59.99	\$0.40 per minute
1350 minutes	\$79.99	\$0.30 per minute

- If a customer expects to use 500 minutes per month, which plan is the best value?
- A cell phone plan consists of a fixed cost (the monthly fee) and a variable cost (charge for extra minutes). Find a linear function that gives the total cost of each plan when x extra minutes are used.
- Using the cost functions from (2) above, determine the cost of using 600 total minutes and 1000 total minutes with each plan. Then determine which plan is the best deal for each level.
